

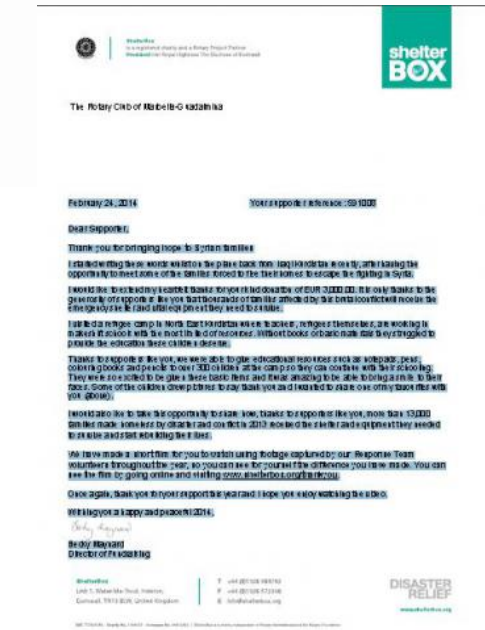

 Dear Supporter,
 Thank you for bringing hope to Syrian families. I started writing these words whilst on the plane back from Iraqi Kurdistan recently, after having the opportunity to meet some of the families forced to flee their homes to escape the fighting in Syria.
 I would like to extend my heartfelt thanks for your kind donation of EUR 3,000.00. It is only thanks to the generosity of supporters like you that thousands of families affected by this brutal conflict will receive the emergency shelter and vital equipment they need to survive. I visited a refugee camp in North East Kurdistan where teachers, refugees themselves, are working in makeshift schools with the most limited of resources. Without books or basic materials they struggled to provide the education these children deserve.
 Thanks to supporters like you, we were able to give educational resources such as notepads, pens, colouring books and pencils to over 300 children at the camp so they can continue with their schooling.

They were so excited to be given these basic items and it was amazing to be able to bring a smile to their faces. Some of the children drew pictures to say thank you and I wanted to share one of my favourites with

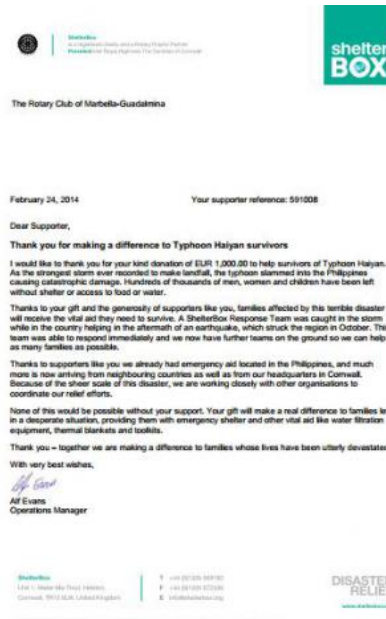
